As you read this, 35 Indians are attending our month long Seminar in Umariasu, Brazil, preparing to become National Church Planters, some of which may use the Letuama NT, or other NT translations among the approximately 12 remaining Un-reached jungle tribes in Colombia. This is an answer to your prayer to "the Lord of Harvest to send out workers"!

PRAISE God for advanced progress in obtaining light plane service to southern Colombia's jungle Tribes, details later. And for a Training Facility for Indigenous peoples that we now have been offered, by our partners, to be part of and teach more advanced courses for our returning students. Starting Fall in 2015.

PRAY for the above, and for Barbro and me to be able to sign the rental (3 bedroom 2 bath) house in Leticia, Amazonas, that the translators now are vacating. Cost \$375/month. We also need to furnish it. If you would like to support us toward the rent payments, please mark your check "House Rent".
