In February Barbro and I had some important meetings with our leadership team in the Amazon, both Colombia and Brazil. The Lord opened up the doors that so long had been shut, to be able for God's messengers to take the Good News to the Tribes in Brazil, the ones who are still waiting!

On the reverse side you'll find a letter I wrote 21 years ago! You'll read about the great team the Lord had put together in order to get us established and on "track"! Now, 20 years later the Colombian Indigenous groups are reached by their Indigenous church planters! Thank you JESUS! And thank you precious Friends for your faithfulness in prayer, giving and serving both us and the Bible Translators, who gave these Tribes the Word of God!

We are expanding the Seminary, Um1, where Ticuna Indian pastor Tito, is the Seminary leader. January 2021, 17 Indian young men (all previously received basic training), will be trained in the method of "Firm Foundations" (evangelizing by telling the Greatest Story Ever Told). Then be sent out two by two to the remaining Tribes in the North Brazilian Amazon.



I will conclude with the words of Walt Fricke: "I look forward to working together toward our mutual goal of ushering in the soon return of our Lord Jesus through the completion of the Great Commission!" You, Walt and the others helped us to enable the Colombian Indigenous groups to know Jesus, now, we're trusting the Lord to direct and supply, according to His will!

I could say a whole lot about these precious people, but I will only say this—they need your prayers as never before. Not because they haven't been successful, but because they are under heavy attack from the enemy of our souls. As we together root out the enemy from his strongholds in the tribes, we need your daily intercession, warfare prayer.

As the relief efforts in Honduras have changed pace into long-range activities, we find ourselves relieved from the duty. We still have an airplane there, but we now concentrate on the intensive courses for church planters in Colombia. Pray for the selecting of candidates, finances, staff training, refurbishing the facility, getting the Magnum plane in to Colombia, getting a twin-engine airplane for the San Andres school, and last but not least, for time to be sufficient for all the activities.

Thank you for your support to us! I wrote to our board members and workers that the task we have is dangerous, difficult and expensive. Walt Fricke said, "I look forward to working together toward our mutual goal of ushering in the soon return of our Lord Jesus through the completion of the Great Commission!"
